

# Retro Flower Power Pillowcase

## Materials You Will Need: (Makes 1 pillowcase)

3/4 yard of a light yellow dot  
1/3 yard of a large gold floral  
2" wide strip for trim  
1/4 yard of a bright print for flower petals  
scrap of a bright solid for flower center

## Cutting Directions:

From the light yellow dot, cut:  
(1) 16" x 28" rectangle

From the bright print, cut:  
(5) Pattern B (petal)

From the large gold floral, cut:  
(2) 3" x 30" strips

From the bright solid, cut:  
(1) Pattern A (center)

## Trimming:

Trim along the selvage side of each of the pieces of the fabric strips so that they are all a uniform 42" long.

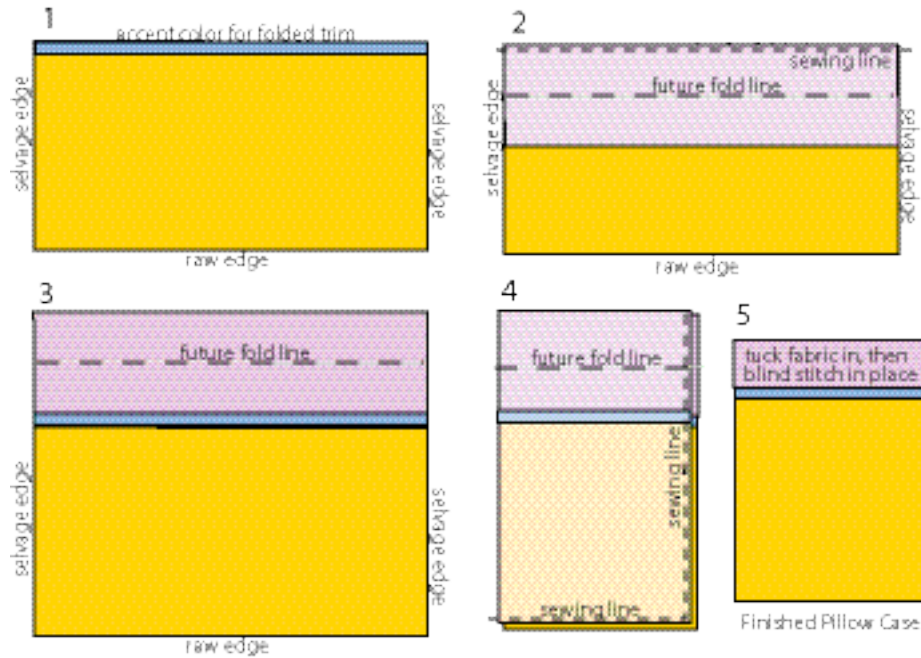
## Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Fold the 1/8 yard contrasting trim strip in half, right sides facing out and press the fold line. Pin this strip to one end of the 3/4 yard pillowcase bottom, raw edges of strip to raw edge of pillowcase fabric.
2. Pin one end of the 1/3 yard fabric to the pillowcase and trim strip, wrong side facing out, right side of this fabric to right side of pillowcase bottom.

3. Fold the end fabric out. Leave the narrow trim strip folded down on the bottom section of the pillowcase. Press the seam line.

4. Fold the stitched together fabric with right sides together. Press the foldline and pin together along the bottom and the long side. Sew together starting at the bottom and then up the long side.

5. Turn right side out. Fold the folded end fabric inside the pillow case to the seam line where it is attached. Turn the raw edge under 1/4" and sew in place by hand or with your sewing machine.



6. (Note: Patterns and instructions are given using the fusible appliqué method. For needle-turn method and add seam allowance to patterns.)

Trace the number indicated of each pattern piece onto the paper side of the fusible web, leaving at least 1/2" space between each piece. Cut out the pieces, 1/4" beyond the drawn lines. Following manufacturer's instructions, iron the pieces to the wrong side of the appropriate fabric. Cut out each piece on the drawn line.

7. Refer to the pillowcase photo; lay out (5) floral petals and (1) center on the front of the pillowcase. Following the manufacturer's instructions, fuse the petals and center in place. Appliqué, using a desired stitch.
