Materials You Will Need:

3/4 yard of a cream floral (includes pillow backing)

1/2 yard of a red stripe

(1) 16" square pillow form

Cutting Directions:

From the cream floral:

(1) 23-1/2" square for the pillow backing

(1) 16-1/2" square

From the red stripe:

(4) 3-1/2" x 25" strips

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Sew the red stripe strips to the sides of the 16-1/2" cream floral square one at a time, matching the center point of each strip to the center points on the sides of the square, and starting and stopping each seam 1/4" from the edges of the square. To complete the pillow front, miter each corner.

2. Layer the pillow front with the 23-1/2" cream floral square, right sides together, leaving a 6" opening on one side for turning. Clip corners and turn right side out. Stitch in the ditch in the seam line joining the red stripe strips to the cream floral square on the pillow front, stitching through all layers and leaving 6" open for inserting the pillow form.

3. Insert the pillow form and stitch both openings closed to finish the pillow.
