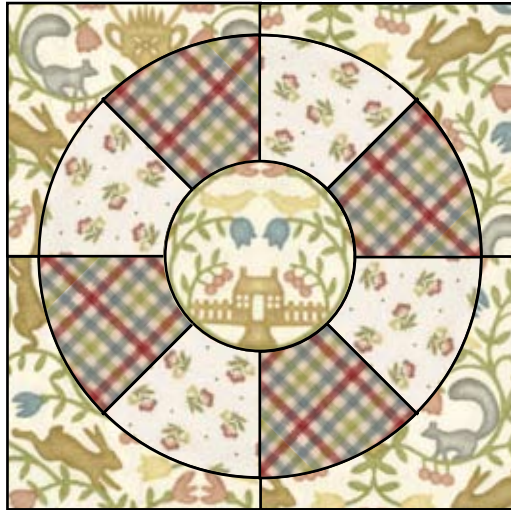


Fabric Stash Block

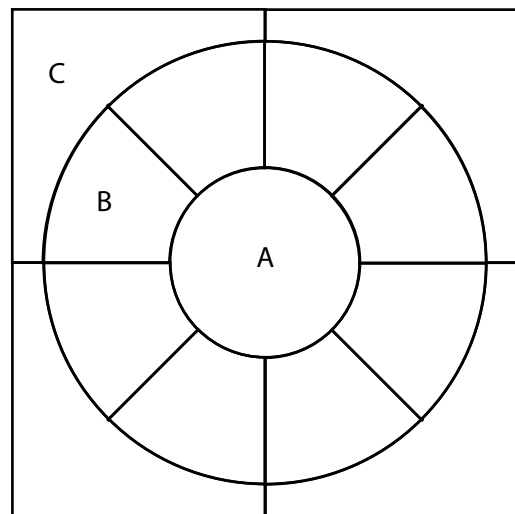

PLEASE NOTE: This fabric stash block first appeared in the Apr/May 2010 issue of QUILT Magazine. Many fabrics have a shelf life of about 6 months to 1 year. These exact fabrics may not still be available for purchase. Take heart! Your favorite quilt shop can help you select suitable substitutes in colors and patterns that will work just as well to make this block.



12" Circle within a Circle Block

Children love to play games, often in loops of fun. This Circle within a Circle block sweetly displays a collection of baby animals romping from Bonnie Sullivan's flannel Woolies collection for Maywood Studio, www.maywoodstudio.com



A - cut (1) Template A



B - cut (4) Template B of each of the two prints



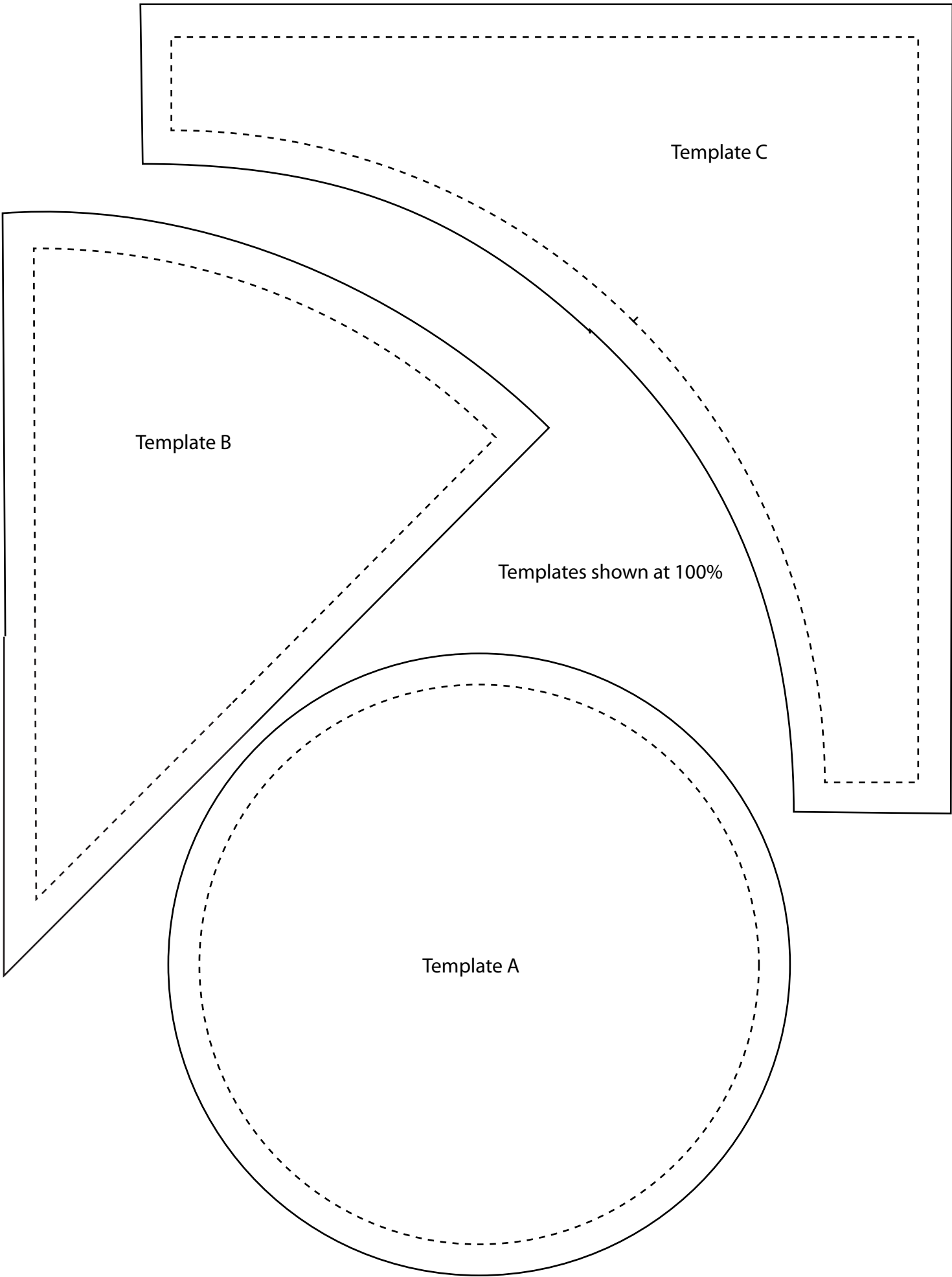
C - cut (4) Template C

ASSEMBLING THE BLOCK:

Refer to block picture above; sew (1) Template B of each print together to make a two-piece unit. Sew the two-piece unit to the curve on (1) Template C corner piece to make a 6-1/2" square. (Make 4 squares)

Lay out the (4) squares in (2) rows of (2) squares each. Sew the squares together in each row. Join the rows.

Turn under 1/4" on the Template A circle and appliqué to the center of the block. Trim the excess fabric from behind the circle to reduce bulk to make a 12-1/2" unfinished Circle within a Circle block.
