Materials You Will Need:

3/8 yard of a rose tonal
3/8 yard of a pink dot
1/4 yard of a red dot
1/4 yard of a white tonal
1-1/2 yards of a medallion print
1-1/2 yards of a backing fabric
(2) 36-1/2" x 26-1/2" pieces of batting
(2) 36-1/2" x 26-1/2" pieces of fabric for lining
6-1/2 yards of decorative trim (optional)

Cutting Directions:

From EACH of the rose tonal and pink dot:
(2) 7-7/8" squares

From the red dot:
(8) 4" squares

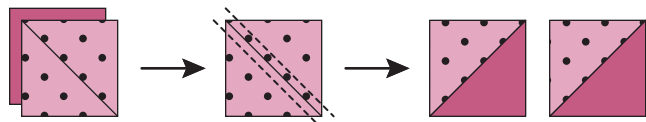
From the white tonal:
(4) 4" squares

From the medallion print:
(4) 10-3/4" squares, cut each square in half on the diagonal to make (2) triangles
(4) 5-5/8" x 22-1/2" strips
(4) 4" squares
(4) 1-5/8" x 20-1/4" strips

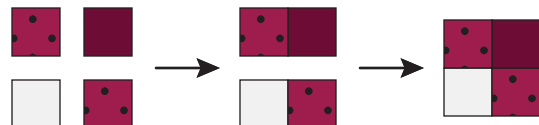
From the backing fabric:
(4) 22-1/2" wide x 20-1/2" high pieces

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

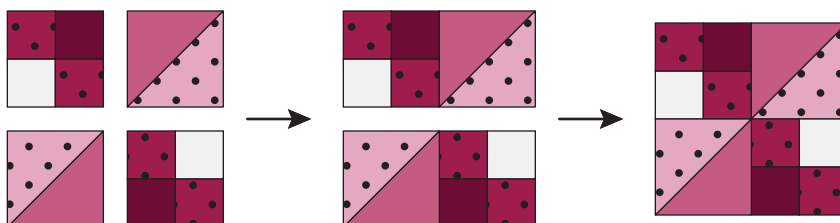
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 7-7/8" pink dot square. Layer the marked square with a 7-7/8" rose tonal square, right sides together. Sew 1/4" away on both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line to make (2) half-square triangle units. Repeat once.



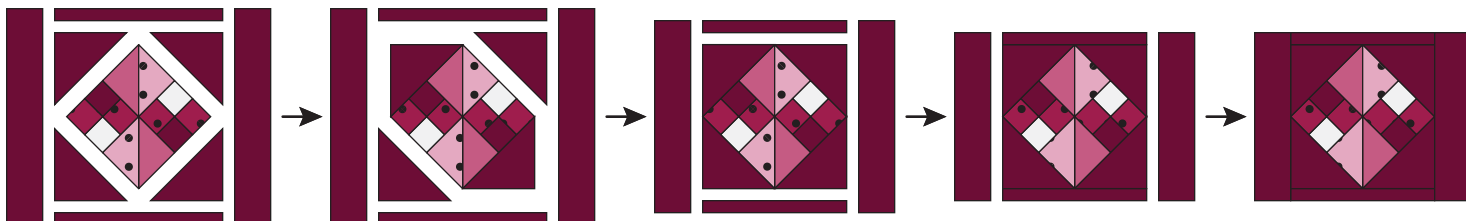
2. Stitch (2) 4" red dot squares, (1) 4" white tonal square, and (1) 4" medallion print square together as shown to make (1) four-patch unit. Repeat to make a total of (4) four-patch units.



3. To make one center square unit, sew together as shown, (2) half square triangle units from step 1 and (2) four-patch units from step 2, noting orientation of all units. Repeat to make a second unit.



4. To assemble one sham front, sew a 10-3/4" medallion print triangle to each side of a unit from step 3. Stitch 1-5/8" x 20-1/4" medallion print strips to the top and bottom of the pieced center square. Sew 5-5/8" x 22-1/2" medallion print strips to the right and left sides of the pieced center square to complete the front of the sham. Repeat once to make a second sham front.



Finishing:

1. Layer each finished sham front with 36-1/2" x 26-1/2" pieces of lining and batting and quilt as desired. Trim all layers even with the outer edges of the sham fronts.
2. If using decorative trim, stitch the trim to each quilted sham front.
3. Fold over 1" twice along one short side of each backing piece. Press and stitch to hem each piece.
4. Layer (1) sham front with (2) backing pieces, right sides together and raw edges even. Pin all layers together and stitch using 1/4" seam allowance. Clip the corners and turn the sham right sides out. Stuff the finished sham with a standard size bed pillow. Repeat to make the second sham.
