Pinwheel Pillow (Makes 2 - 14” square pillows)

Materials You Will Need:

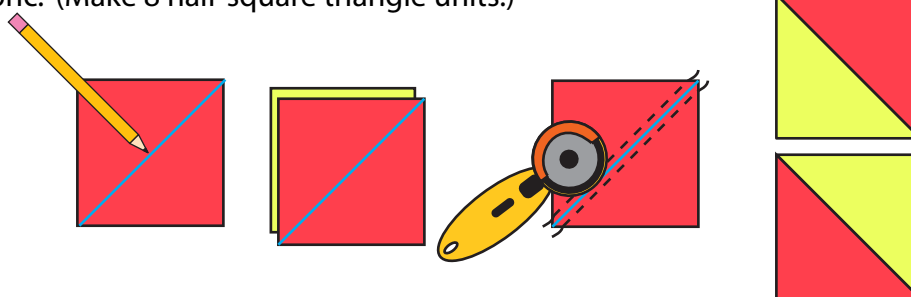
- (8) 8” squares - (4) of light prints and (4) of dark prints
- 1/2 yard of backing fabric
- (2) 14” square Fairfield Poly-fil Soft Touch Pillow Forms
- (2) 1-1/2” round buttons

Cutting Directions:

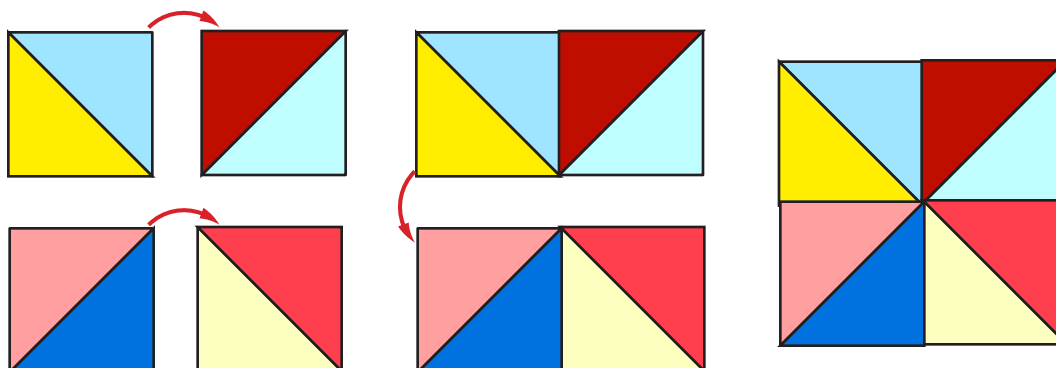
- From the backing fabric, cut:
(4) 15” x 10” pieces

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4” unless stated otherwise)*

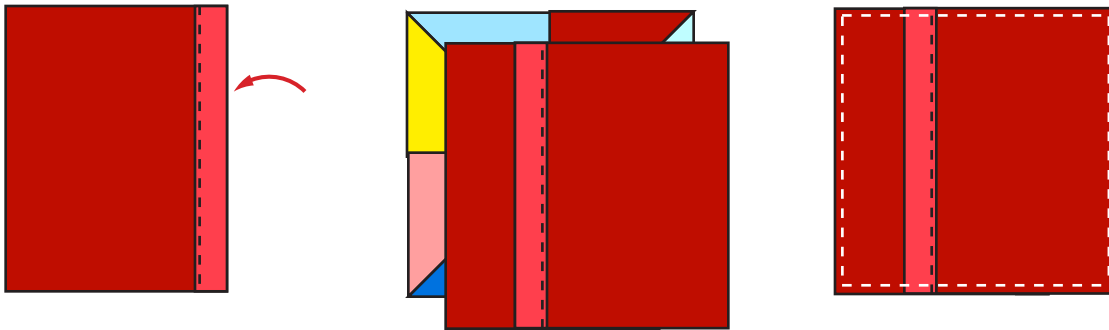
1. To form the pinwheel, take (1) 8” light fabric square and place it on top of (1) dark fabric square, right sides together and raw edges even. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the light square. Stitch 1/4” away on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to form (2) half-square triangle units. Press seams toward the darker fabric. (Make 8 half-square triangle units.)



2. Sew (4) half-square triangle units together to make a Pinwheel block, alternating the light and dark colors when forming your pinwheel. Press and trim to a 15” square. Sew a 1-1/2” round button to the center of the pinwheel.



3. For the pillow backing, hem (1) 10" raw edge of each 15" x 10" piece to make a back panel. (Make 4 panels.) Layer the pillow front (right side up) and (2) back panels (right side down), as shown. Pin and stitch with 1/4" around the complete square. Trim the corners and turn right side out. Insert the 14" square pillow form.



Basket Pillow (Makes 1- 12" x 16" pillow)

Materials You Will Need:

- 1/3 yard of a red floral
- 1/4 yard of a white solid
- 5/8 yard of a yellow print
- 1/8 yard of a blue floral
- (3) 6" square scraps for flowers and leaves
- (1) 12" x 16" Fairfield Poly-fil Soft Touch Pillow Form

Cutting Directions:

From the red floral cut:

- (2) 2-1/4" x 16-1/2" strips
- (2) 4-1/4" 8-1/2" strips

From the white solid, cut:

- (2) 3-1/2" squares
- (1) 6-1/2" x 10" strip

From the yellow print, cut:

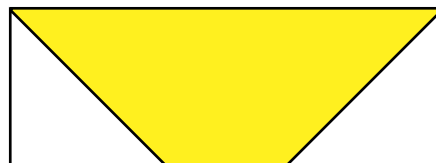
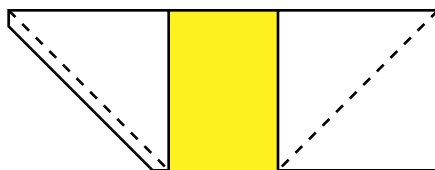
- (1) 3-1/2" x 10" strip
- (2) 13" x 20" pieces

From the blue floral, cut:

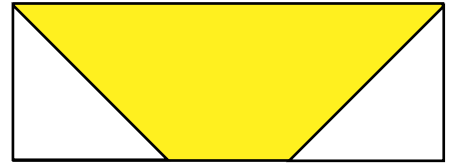
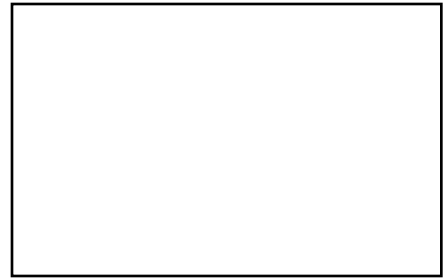
- (2) 1" x 8-1/2" strips
- (2) 1" x 10" strips

Sewing Directions: *(Seam allowance is 1/4" unless stated otherwise)*

1. Measure 1/2" in from the center (5 inches) of a 10 x 3.5 inch rectangle (basket bottom fabric) on each side and pin one 3.5 inch square (basket background fabric) on the right side and one on the left 1/2 inch from the center. Beginning with the left block, sew a line from the left upper corner to the left lower corner, forming a basket triangle. Press seams toward the darker fabrics. The basket is formed.



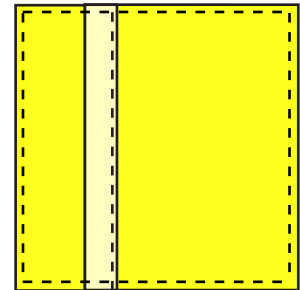
2. Sew the 10 x 6.5 inch Basket background fabric to the 10 x 3.5 basket along the 10 inch edge. Press. Cut the flowers and leaves out and applique' on the background fabric. Sew along the flowers and leaves with a blanket stitch. Trim block to a 7 1/2 inch square. Trim and press.



3. Sew one 8 1/2 x 1" strip to each side of the 7 1/2 inch square. Trim and press. Sew one 10 x 1" strip to the top and one to the bottom of the 7 1/2 inch square. Press and trim to an 8" square.

4. Sew one 4 1/3" strip on each side of the 8" square to outline the basket square. Trim, press. Sew one 2 1/4" x 16 1/2" strip to the top of the basket square and one to the bottom to complete the pillow front.

5. Hem each of the 13 x 20" pillow backing panels on the 13" raw edge. Overlap one panel over the other (three inches) with the hemmed edges in opposite directions and the right side of the fabric up. Center the Flower basket Pillow top on top of the panels, right sides together. Pin and stitch with an 1/4" around the edges of the wrong side of the pillow top. Trim excess and turn. Fill with a 12 x 16" pillow form.
