Scrappy Cone Shapes

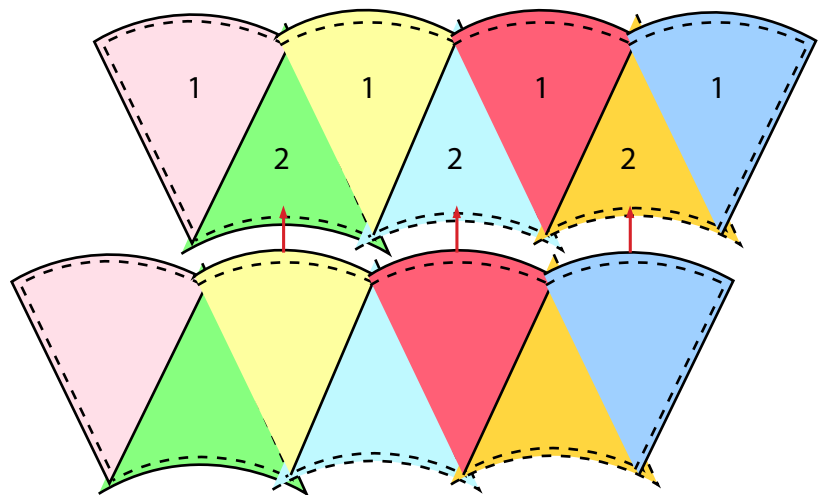
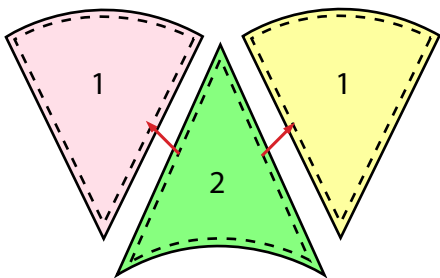

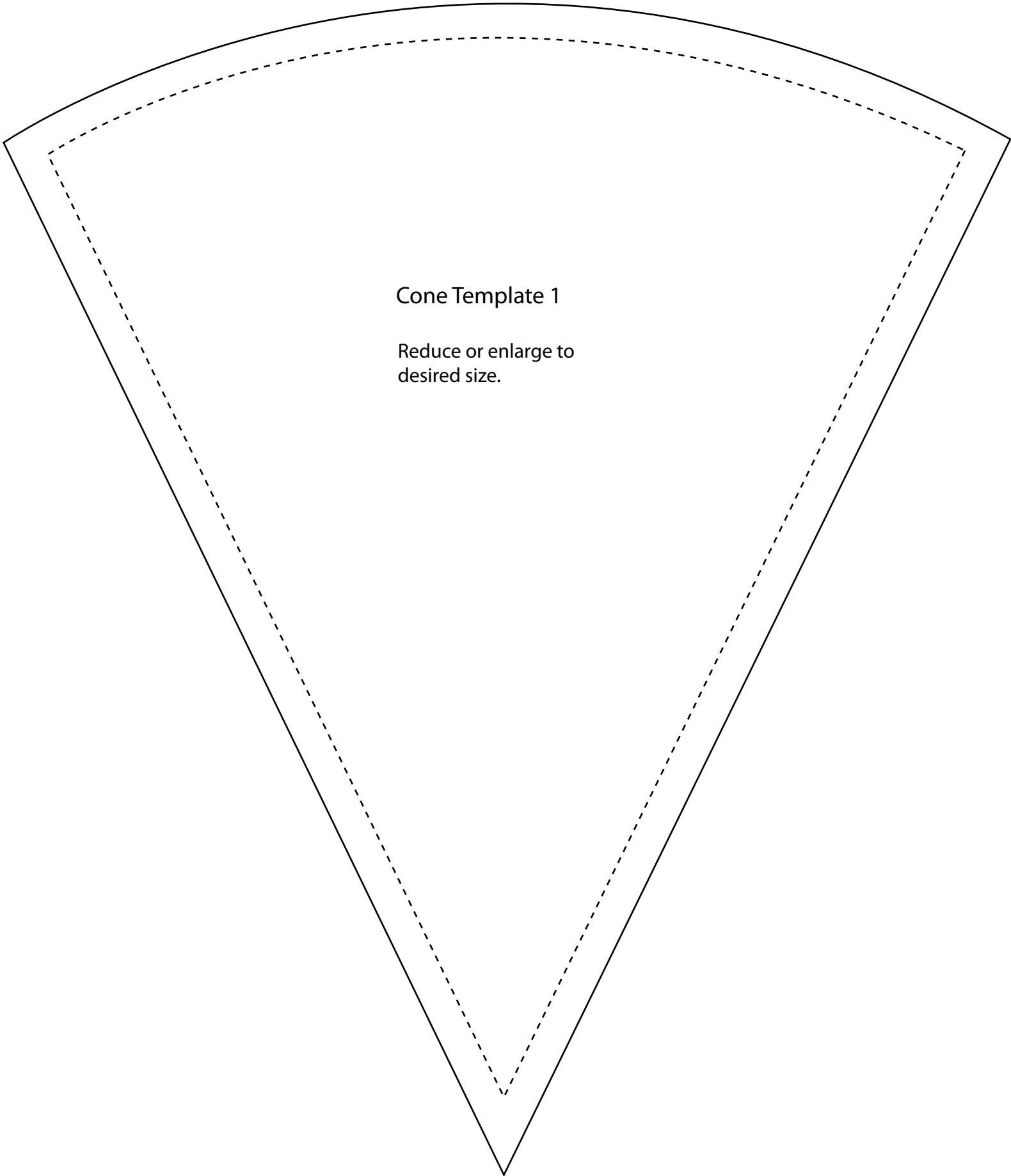


Assembly:

Using this one-patch design does not require individual block construction, but individual piecing of each one-patch design piece.

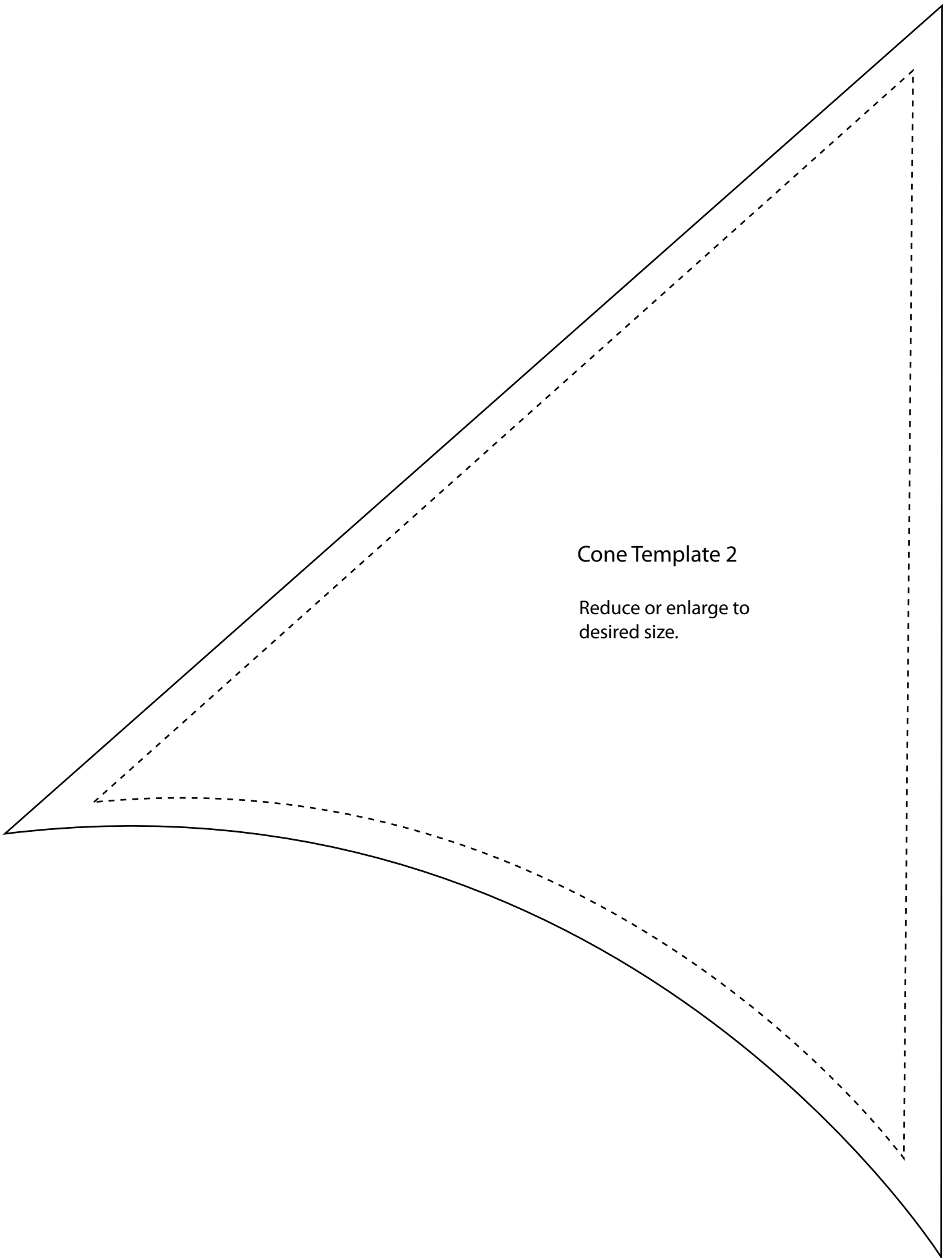
The sides of each cone template 1 can be joined to cone template 2 starting and stopping 1/4" from each corner. Center the curved edges when joining the rows.
