# Looking for Fun Pillow

## Materials:

2/3 yard of a green dot  
3/4 yard of a large floral  
9" x 20" pillow form

## Cutting:

From the green dot:

- (1) 20-1/2" x 28-1/2" piece
- (2) 9" circles (Template A)

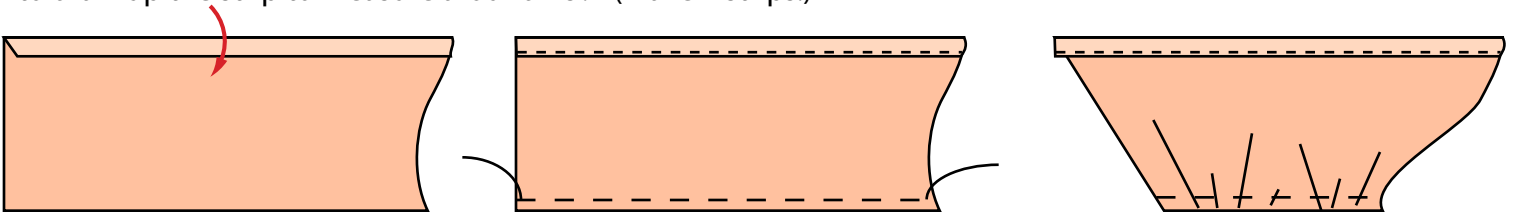
From the large floral:

- (3) 5" x 42" strips
- (2) 3-1/2" x 40" strips

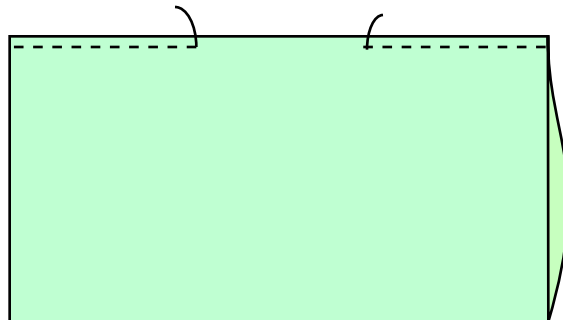
## Sewing Directions:

*Note: Use a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise stated.*

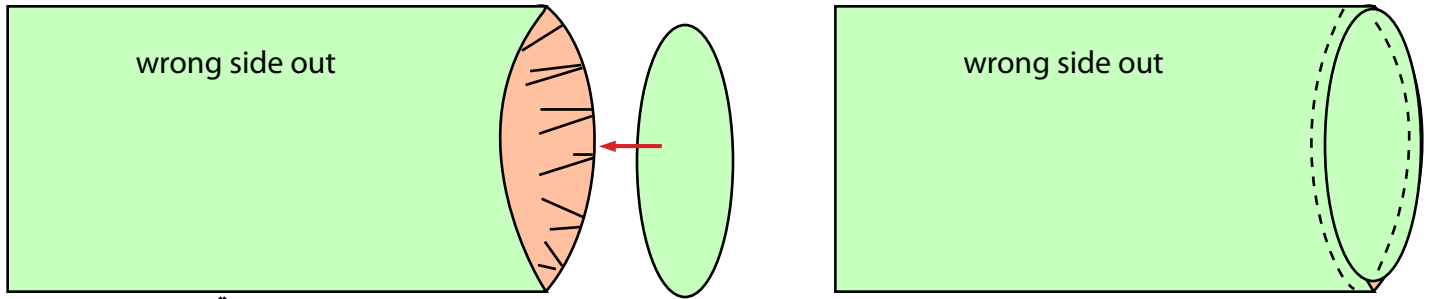
1. Stitch the short ends together of the (3) 5" x 42" large floral strips to make a long strip. Crosscut the long strip into (2) 60" strips. Fold 1/2" to the wrong side on one long side of the strip and press. Fold 1/2" to the wrong side again and press. Stitch the folded edge to hem. Pleat or run gathering stitches on the other long side of the strip to draw up the strip to measure around 28". (Make 2 strips.)



2. Sew the short side of the 20-1/2" x 28-1/2" green dot piece, right sides together to make a tube leaving an opening for inserting the pillow form.



3. Turn the tube inside out and pin the gathered side of (1) large floral strip, right sides together around the inside of the end of the green dot tube, slightly overlapping the strip ends where they come together. Pin (1) 9" green dot circle to the inside of the tube over the gathered strip, right sides together. Carefully sew around the end of the tube through all of the layers. Repeat on the other end of the tube. Turn the tube right side out and press. Insert the pillow form through the side opening. Slip stitch the opening closed.



4. Sew (2) 3-1/2" x 40" large floral strips, right sides together around three sides as shown. Turn right side out and press. Slip stitch the opening closed. Tie around the pillow.
