Floral Button Wrap

Materials:

- 1/2 yard of a light blue zigzag
- 1/8 yard of an orange/blue floral
- 1/4 yard of 20" wide lightweight, double-sided fusible webbing

Cutting:

- LIGHT BLUE ZIGZAG
- (1) 10-1/2" x 36" strip

- ORANGE/BLUE FLORAL
- Reserve for appliqué

Sewing Directions:

Note: Use a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise stated.

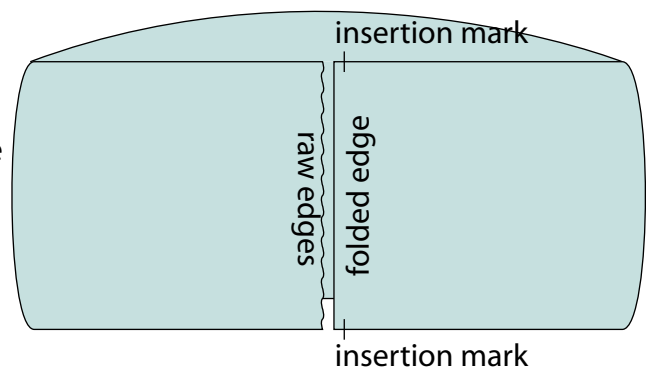
1 Fold the 10-1/2" x 36" light blue zigzag strip right sides together, lengthwise. Stitch lengthwise, using a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the tube right side out, align seam along the center of one side, and press to create a finished sleeve.

2 Following manufacturer's directions, press fusible web to the back side of the orange/blue floral fabric. Fussy cut (7) flower motifs. Handstitch the center of each flower motif to the sleeve, evenly spaced, using a gold seed bead to embellish.

FINISHING

1 Fold the raw edges in one end of the wrap to create a finished edge. Position the wrap around the pillow and mark where the raw edges meet the folded end. Remove the wrap from the pillow, insert the raw edges into the folded end to the marked spot, and stitch down the folded end to secure.

2 Stuff the pillow inside the wrap, centering as desired.



Appliqué Garden Wrap

Materials:

2/3 yard of a beige paisley
1/2 yard of a light blue paisley
1/4 yard each of a green floral and an orange floral
1/2 yard of 20" wide lightweight, double-sided fusible webbing

Cutting:

BEIGE PAISLEY
(1) 1-1/2" x 36" strip

LIGHT BLUE PAISLEY
(1) 10" x 36" strip

GREEN FLORAL AND ORANGE FLORAL
Reserve for appliqué

Sewing Directions:

Note: Use a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise stated.

1 Sew the 1-1/2" x 36" beige paisley strip lengthwise to the 10" x 36" light blue paisley strip.

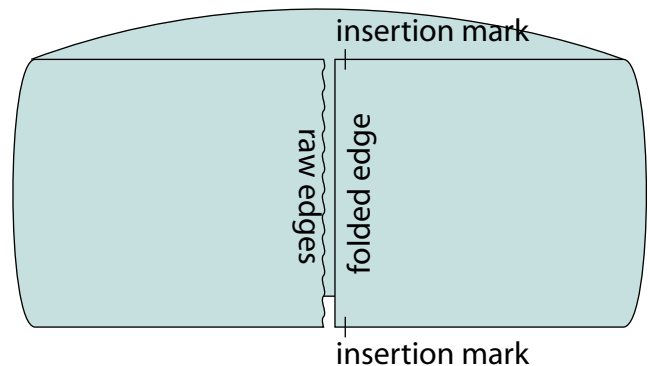
2 Following manufacturer's directions, press fusible web to the back side of the green floral and orange floral fabrics. Using the photo for inspiration, fussy cut flower and leaf motifs from the prints. Arrange the shapes on the sleeve front along the blue/beige seam line and fuse in place. Secure with a decorative edge or freeform machine stitching.

3 Stitch the remaining long sides of the beige and blue sleeve right sides together. Turn the tube right sides out and press so that the beige strip shows along the bottom front.

FINISHING

1 Fold the raw edges in one end of the wrap to create a finished edge. Position the wrap around the pillow and mark where the raw edges meet the folded end. Remove the wrap from the pillow, insert the raw edges into the folded end to the marked spot, and stitch down the folded end to secure.

2 Stuff the pillow inside the wrap, centering as desired.
