## Lined Baskets

### Materials:

1-2 yards of a print fabric  
Square or rectangular basket of choice

### Sewing Directions:

*Note: Use a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise stated.*

- 1 Measure the sides, ends, and bottom of the basket. Add 1" to the length and width of the basket bottom and cut a fabric piece to that size. Add 1" to the length and 4" to the height of the basket sides and ends. Cut (2) fabric pieces each for the sides and ends.
- 2 Stitch the fabric sides to the long sides of the bottom fabric piece. Stitch the fabric ends to the bottom and sides.
- 3 Hem the top edge of the fabric liner by folding the top edge under 1/4" and then 1/4" again and stitching.
- 4 Insert the liner into the basket and fold the hemmed edges over the top edge of the basket.

## Braided Rug

### Materials:

A variety of torn 2"-wide strips  
8 yards of 3/4" to 7/8" wide cording  
Large sharp needle

### Making the Rug:

- 1 Wrap strips around the cording, overlapping each wrap by about 1/2". When you get near the end of a strip, tie on another strip. Trim knots. Continue wrapping the cording.
- 2 Stitch the cording into a circle using a long running stitch. Continue wrapping the cord to create a flat, round rug shape.
