



Cute for Kids Nursing Cover

“Cute for Kids” diaper bag patterned in the Simple Quilts & Sewing - Sp 2012 issue

Project size: 23” x 37”

Materials:

3/4 yard of a large floral
1/8 yard of a small check
(2) 1-1/4” D rings
1/2 yard of boning

Cutting:

From floral fabric:
(1) 25” x 39” rectangle

From check fabric:
(1) 3” x 42” strip

From boning, cut;
(1) 15” length

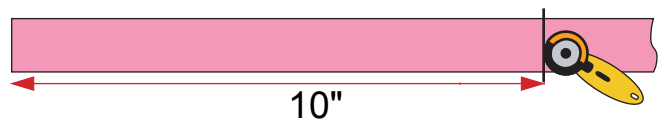
Sewing Directions: *Note: Use a 1/4” seam allowance unless otherwise stated.*

Making the Straps:

1. Press 1/2” to the wrong side along both long edges of check strip. With wrong sides together, fold strip in half, the length of the strip, matching the folded edges.

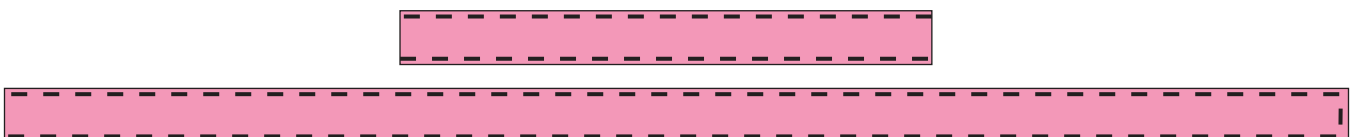


2. Cut (1) 10” length from the strip.



3. Fold the cut ends in to make a neat finish at one end of the long strap.

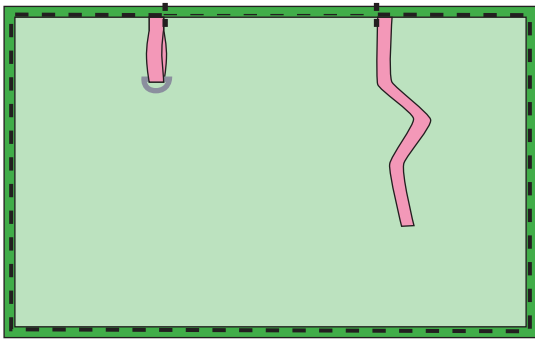
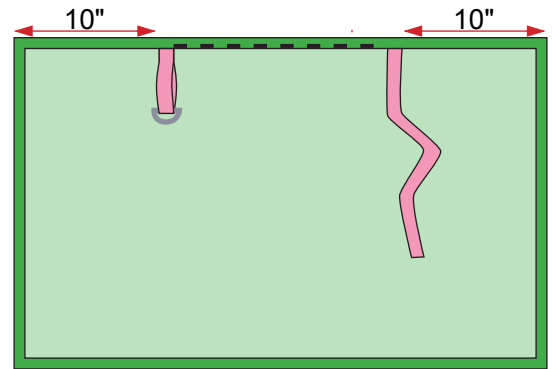
4. Topstitch 1/8” along both long edges of each strap, including the finished end of the long strap.



Making the Nursing Cover:

1. Press the edges of floral rectangle 1/4" to wrong side. Press edges over another 3/4" to wrong side.

2. Slide the (2) D rings onto the small strap. Tuck both unfinished ends of the small strap into the top fold 10" from the left side. Tuck the unfinished end of the long strap into the top fold 10" from the right side. Topstitch 1/8" from inside edge of folded edge down between the straps to create a casing for the boning.



3. In a well ventilated area, melt the ends of the boning with a match. This will stop the boning from sticking sharp ends into you or the baby.

4. Slide the boning into the casing between the straps. Stitch the ends of the casing closed so the boning can't shift.

5. Stitch 1/8" along inside edge all the way around the folded edges of cover. Be sure to catch the strap ends in the stitching.

6. Thread long strap through D rings. Adjust as needed.
